Identify possible use cases

- ☐ Review any blockers to achieving your business goals

- ☐ Speak to peers about how they're using GenAl and what's working
- ☐ Dig into your business data to spot hidden trends or areas for improvement
- ☐ Look outside your industry for innovative use cases



Involve and educate employees

- ☐ Explain how GenAl will help to make your startup more innovative
- ☐ Inspire your team with examples of how other startups use GenAI
- ☐ Ask staff where they think GenAl could be used in your business
- ☐ Be open about potential uses don't automatically discount ideas
- ☐ Educate staff on safety guidelines, e.g. managing data protection risks
- □ Be vigilant about job security concerns and seek to alleviate fears

Prioritise and test ideas

- Prioritise ideas to test, either by impact or ease of implementation
- ☐ Define what success will look like for each idea
- ☐ Set a clear roadmap for testing, factoring in time scale and resources
- ☐ Compare the impact of using GenAl to previous processes
- ☐ Evaluate the human effort that's needed to support GenAl use
- □ Refine and improve the process if successful, or move onto your next idea
